\*Item # 13, Mobile Home Unit Site: When installing a site service in a park, the permit application must include the application fee, service, the number of park sites, and a final inspection. When setting a HUD mobile home in a park, a permit must include the application fee, service, feeder, and a final inspection. These shall be done by a licensed electrical contractor. When setting a HUD mobile home or a pre-manufactured home on private property, a permit must include the application fee, service, feeder, and a final inspection.

\*\*EVSE – Electrical Vehicle Supply Equipment, PV Modules - Photovoltaic

#### ELECTRICAL PERMIT APPLICATION

Plans must be submitted with an application for plan examination and the appropriate deposit before a permit can be issued, except as listed below.

Plans are not required for the following:

- 1. When the electrical system rating does not exceed 400 amps and the building is not over 3,500 square feet in area.
- 2. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00

If work is being performed as described above, check "No" in the "Plan Review" section.

What is the rating of the service or feeder in ampere?

What is the building size in square footage?

Plans are required for all other building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervisor of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to 1980 PA 299 and shall bear that architect's or engineer's seal and signature.

### Instructions for Completing Application

General: Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with KABA. All installations shall be in conformance with the Michigan Electrical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. When ready for inspection, call KABA, providing as much advance notice as possible. KABA will need the job location and/or permit number.

Expiration of Permit: Every permit issued shall become invalid unless the work authorized by such permit is commenced within 180 days after its issuance, or if the work authorized by such permit is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 days after the time the work is commenced. A PERMIT WILL BE CLOSED WHEN NO INPSECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED Date Paid:\_\_\_\_\_ WITHIN 180 DAYS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CLOSED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED.
