Domestic water treatment and filtering equipment: If a permit is secured, required inspections are performed and the installation complies with the applicable code, a license is not required for the installation of domestic water treatment and filtering equipment that requires modification to an existing cold water distribution supply and associated water piping in buildings. If the enforcing agency determines a violation exists, it shall be corrected by the responsible installer. The permit application shall include the application fee, the number of water treatment devices recorded in item #25 for \$5.00 each, and the appropriate water distribution pipe (system) size fee.

Supplement to Plumbing Permit Application

PLUMBING PERMIT APPLICATION

Plans must be submitted with an Application for Plan Examination and the appropriate deposit before a permit can be issued, except as listed below.

Plans are not required for the following:

- 1. One and two family dwellings containing not more than 3,500 square feet of building area
- 2. Alterations and repair work determined by the Plumbing Official to be of a minor nature
- 3. Buildings with a required plumbing fixture count less than 12
- 4. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00.

If work is being performed as described above, check "No" in the "Plan Review" section.

<u>Plans are required</u> for all other building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervisor of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to 1980 PA 299 and shall bear that architect's or engineer's seal and signature.

Instructions for Completing Application

General: Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with KABA. All					
installations shall be in conformance with the Michigan Plumbing Code. No work shall be concealed until it has					
been inspected. When ready for an inspection, call KABA, providing as much advance notice as possible.					
KABA will need the job location and/or permit number.

invalid unless the work authorized by such permit is					

invalid unless the work authorized by such permit is commenced within 180 days after its issuance, or if the work authorized by such permit is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 days after the time the work is commenced. A PERMIT WILL BE CLOSED WHEN NO INPSECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN 180 DAYS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CLOSED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED
