Approval of Agenda – Alwine requested an addition of Information Security & Privacy Policy under 5. Business as item e. A motion was made by Harma to approve the amended agenda, seconded by Leuty, motion carried.

- **5. a. General Insurance Renewal** <u>Harma motioned to approve the General Insurance Renewal as presented and authorized Alwine to sign the acceptance, seconded by Smith, and carried with a vote 7-0.</u>
- **5. b. 2023 Employee Wage Approval** A handout was presented to the board members. <u>Harma motioned to approve a pay increase for all employees at 5.9%, seconded by Lewis, and carried with a vote 7-0.</u>
- **5. c. STD/LTD/Life Insurance Renewal** <u>Smith motion to approve the STD/LTD/Life Insurance renewal as presented, seconded by Leuty and carried with a vote 7-0.</u>
- **5. d. Permit Fee Schedule** <u>Harma motioned to approve the permit fee schedule, with the trade inspection fee increasing to \$50 per inspection and a 3.5% increase to the building permit fees, seconded by Lewis, and carried with a vote 7-0.</u>
- **5. e. Information Security & Privacy Policy** Alwine offered details of the Cybersolutions Liability within KABA's general insurance package and requested permission to obtain assistance from KABA legal counsel for creation of a policy. Harma motioned to authorize Alwine to acquire

assistance from KABA legal counsel in creation of Information Security & Privacy Policy, seconded by Lewis, and carried with a vote 7-0.

KABA Board Member Comments – Thompson announced Comstock Township received an award from the MEDC for certified redevelopment ready community.

KABA Staff Comments – Alwine thanked the board members for their continuous support.
